





Entries are invited for the first edition of the Goa Environmental Film Festival to be held in Panaji, Goa, from 3-5th June 2023, on the sidelines of the G20 summit of nations.

The festival is open and free to the public. Film has the unique ability to transport us to different corners of the world, allowing us to witness the wonders of nature and the challenges and the idea of the festival is create awareness and present films that are thought-provoking and ones that inspire, educate, and ignite conversations about the state of our planet and the urgent need for environmental action.

The Goa Environmental Film Festival invites Indian filmmakers to submit their films - short, documentaries and feature films premiered online or at any festival around the world, after $1^{\rm st}$ January 2020, for consideration at the festival. The submission has to be made via an online link and the last date for submitting the same is $28^{\rm th}$ May 2023, up to 6.00 pm.

If the film is in any other language apart from English, there should be English subtitles for the same. The producer or the director of the film must be an Indian citizen. Along with the online link, a synopsis along with the cast and crew details should also be sent. The film should have a theme related to the environment.

A jury comprising of not more than 5 members will evaluate the films and their decision will be final and binding and no appeal will be entertained.
